

Technical requirements

Notes

If necessary & if I travel by car I can bring these materials:

- (1) fishman loudbox artist; (1) microphone with boom; (1) shure Beta 58a vocal mic;
- (1) drum stool

If I travel otherwise I can only bring this: (1) shure Beta 58a vocal mic and (1) drum stool

I play a lot of subtleties on guitar, this soft and detailed guitar playing requires the general house mix to be loud enough.

I put a **polytune pedal** between my output of the guitar and the DI box. So this requires 2 jack cables instead of one.

My guitar systems

Blueridge BR43 CE: needs **(2) jack cables**: one for passive percussive pickup (something like a K&K pure mini) and one for my onboard fishman presys+ preamp. These **both need a DI BOX** and the sound needs to be mixed together.

Larrivee: has a **stereo output** with an external K&K Powermix Pure XT , with a stereo input and jack output to connect with the DI (see picture)
